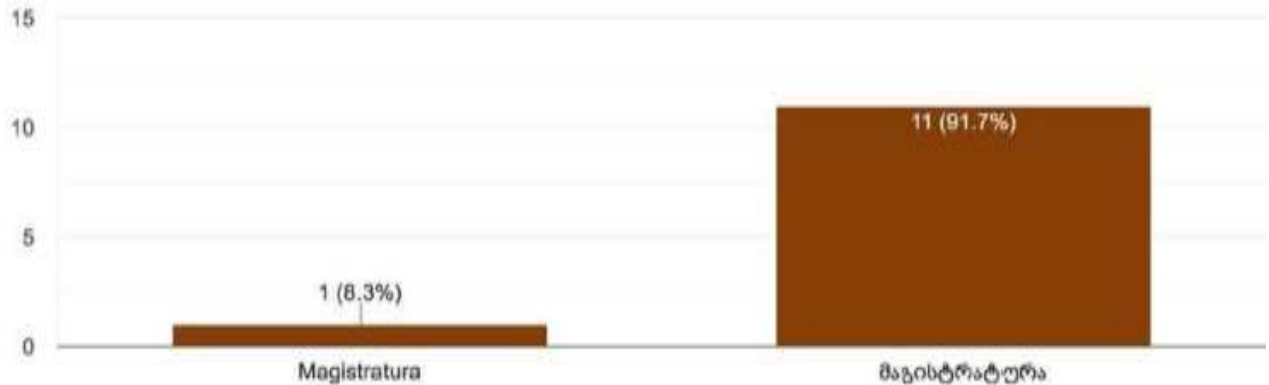

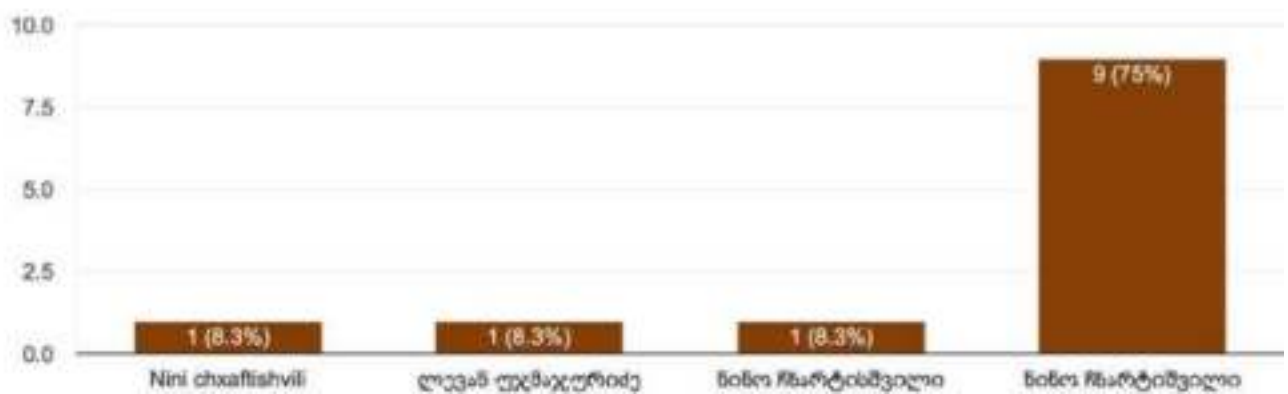

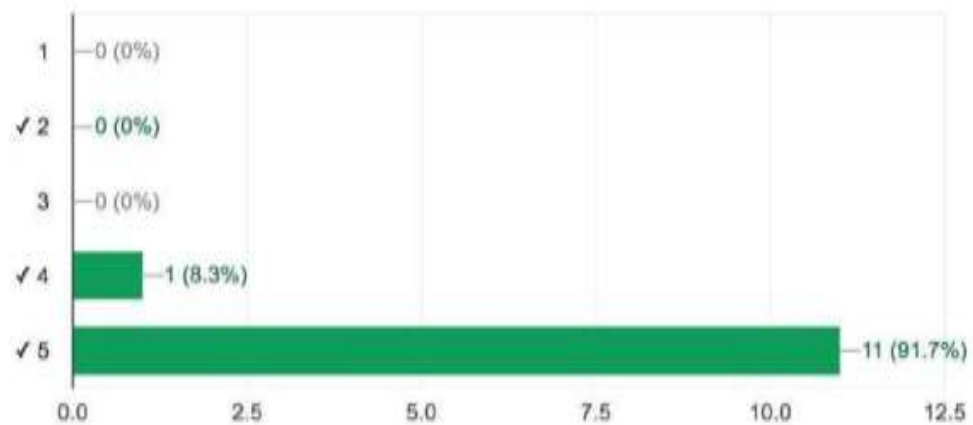

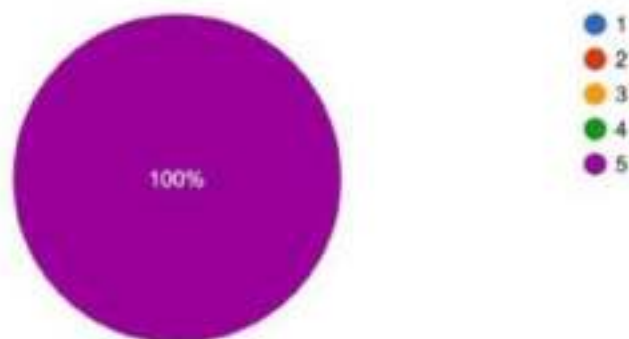

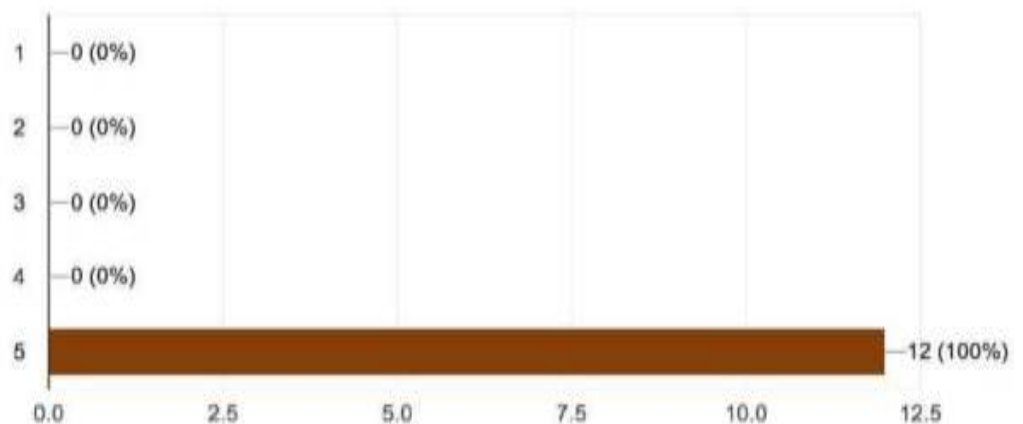

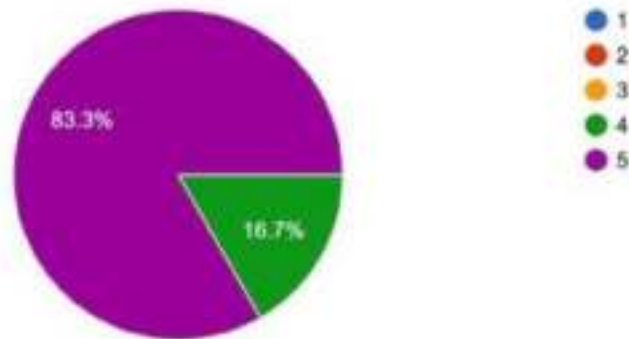

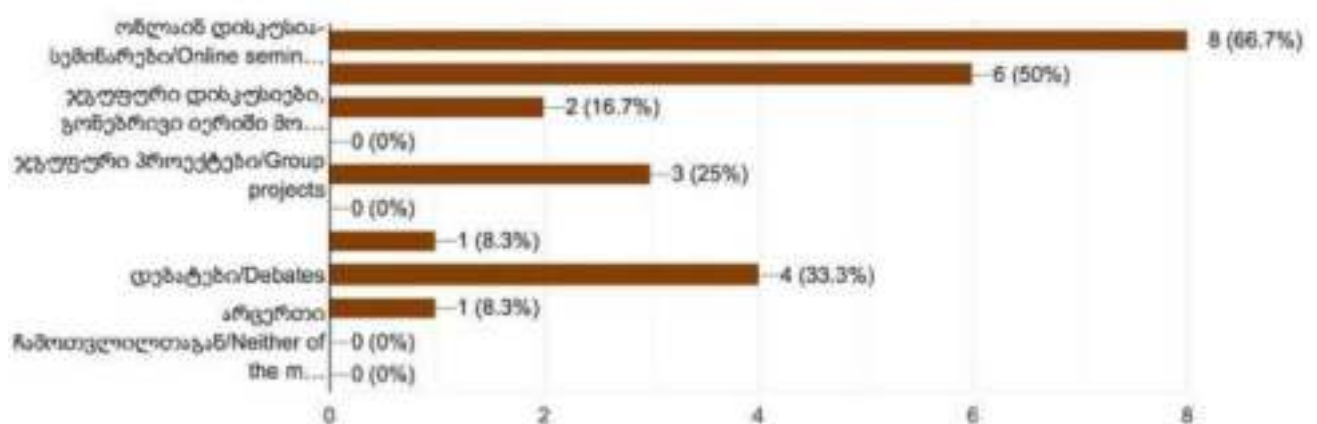

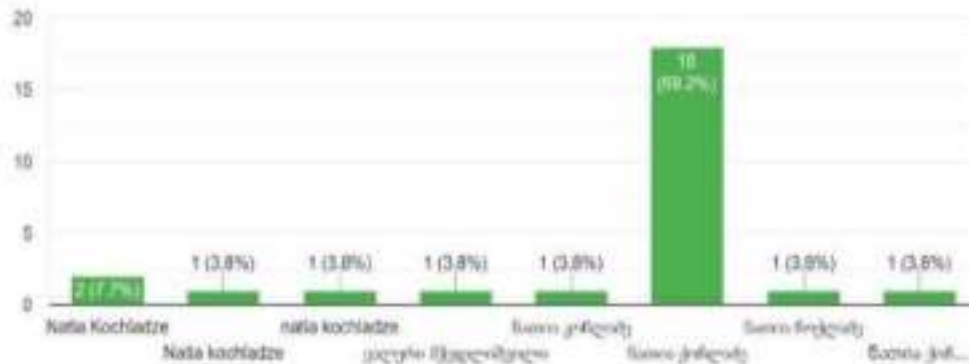

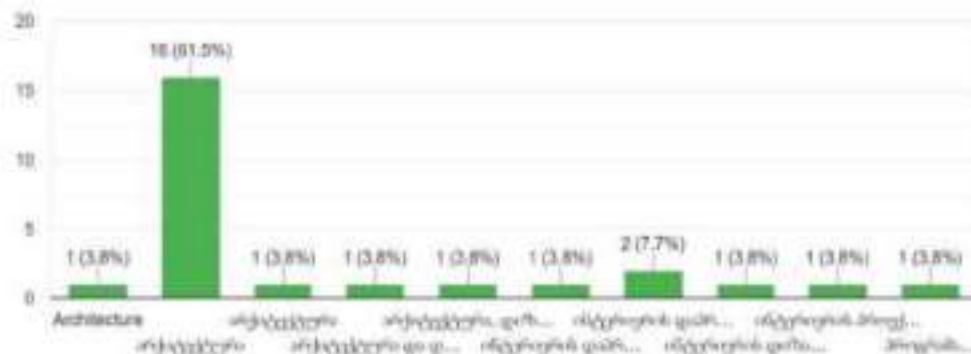

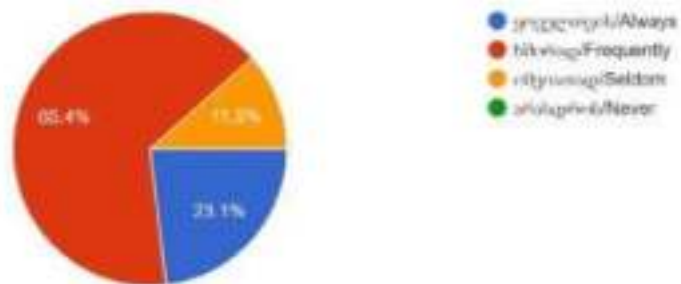

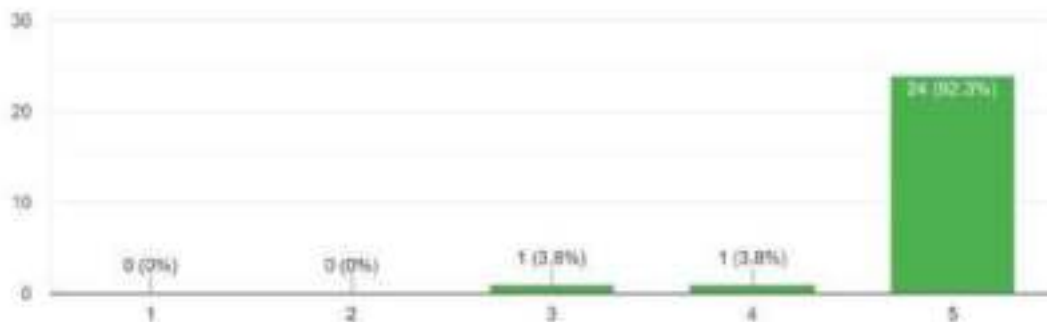

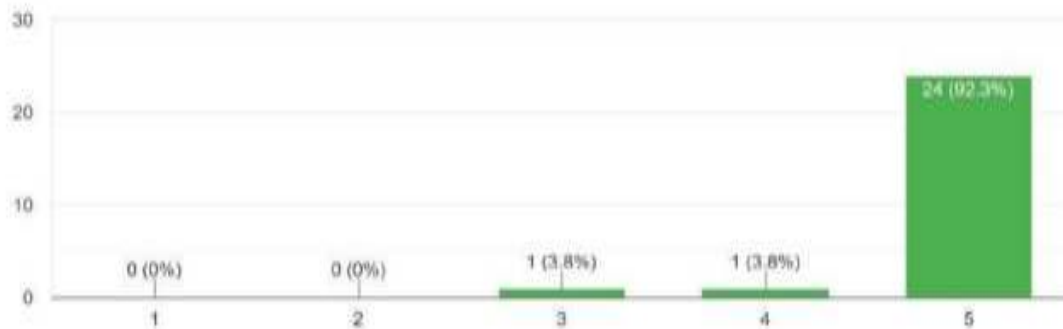

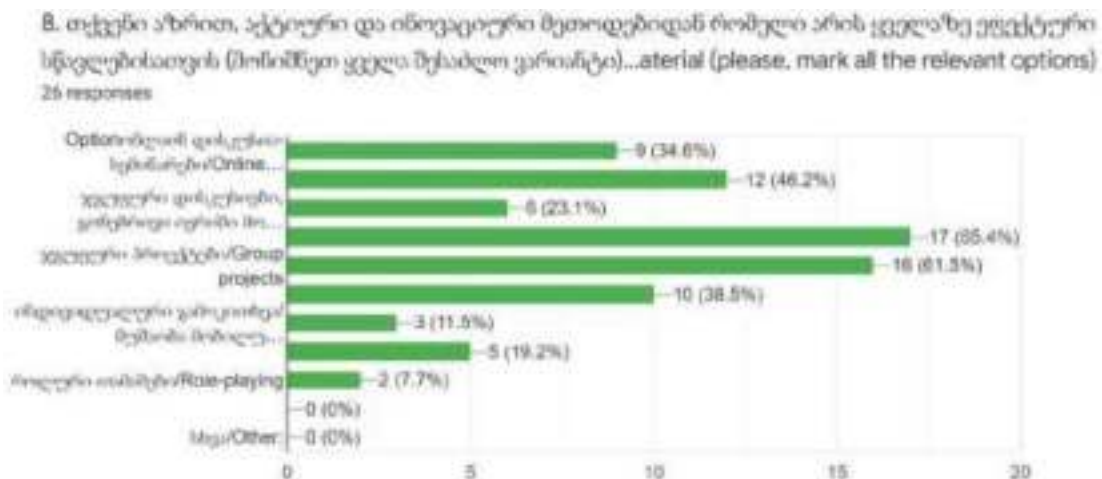

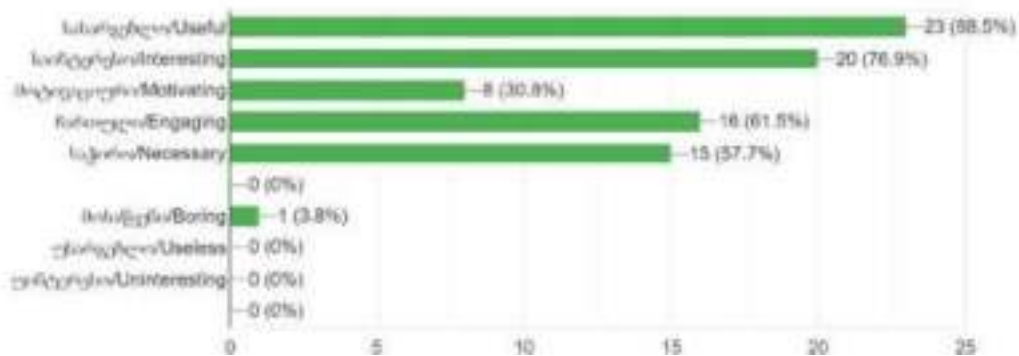

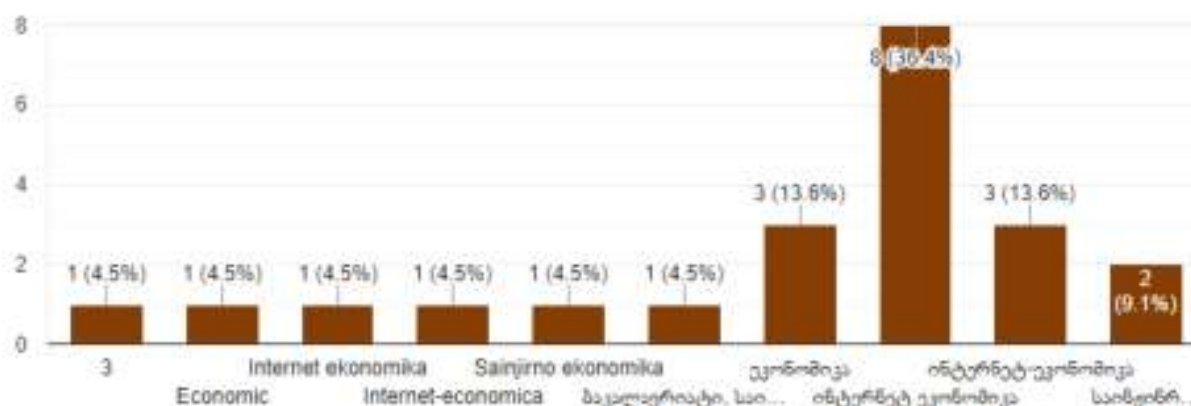

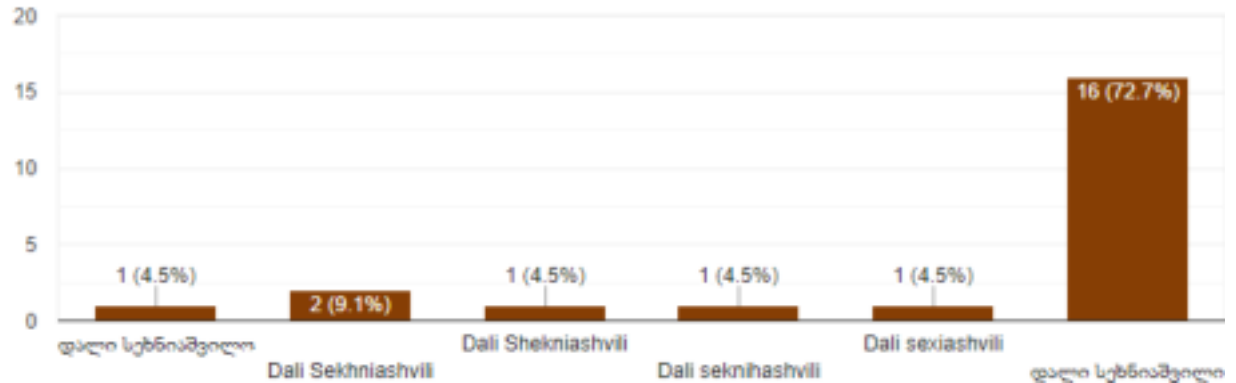

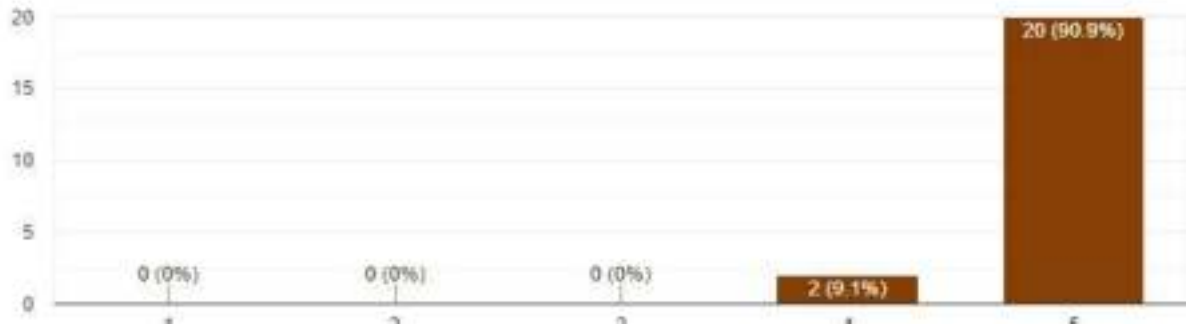

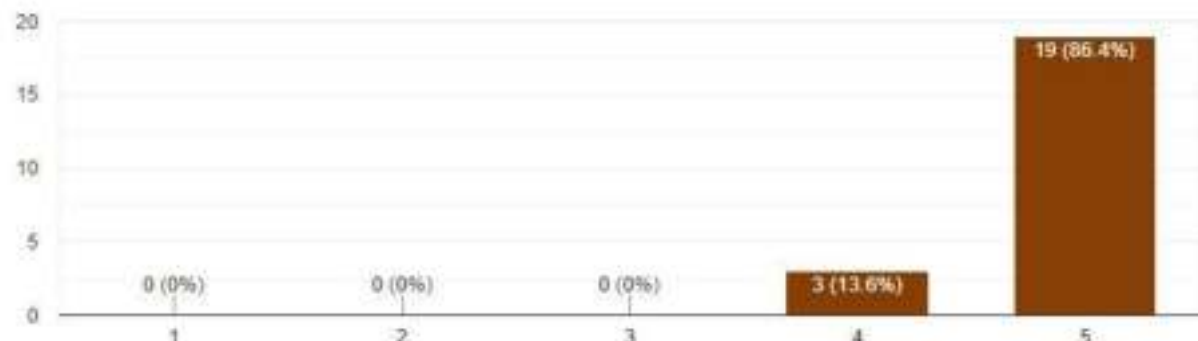

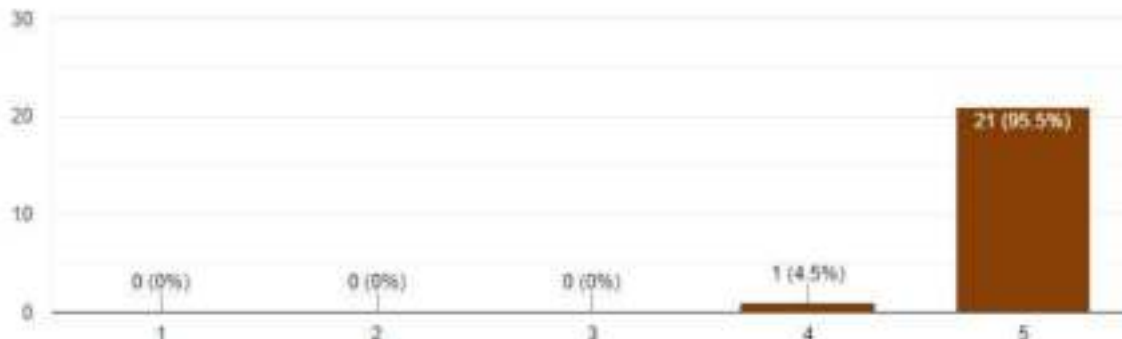

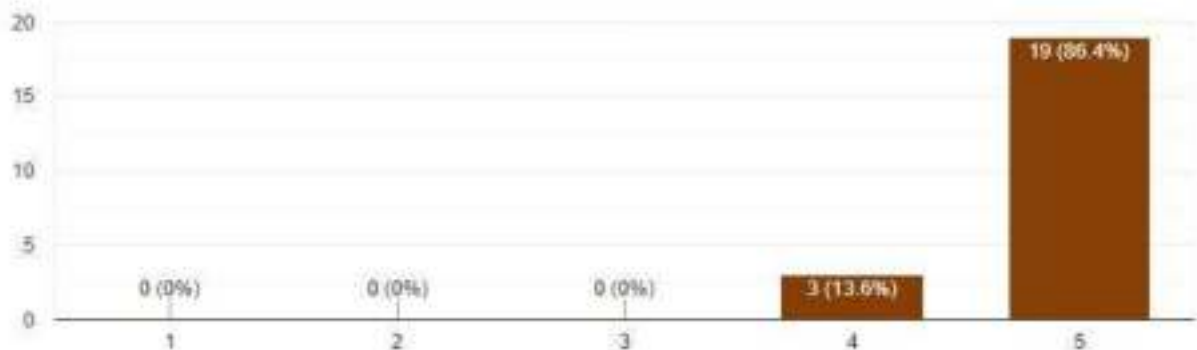

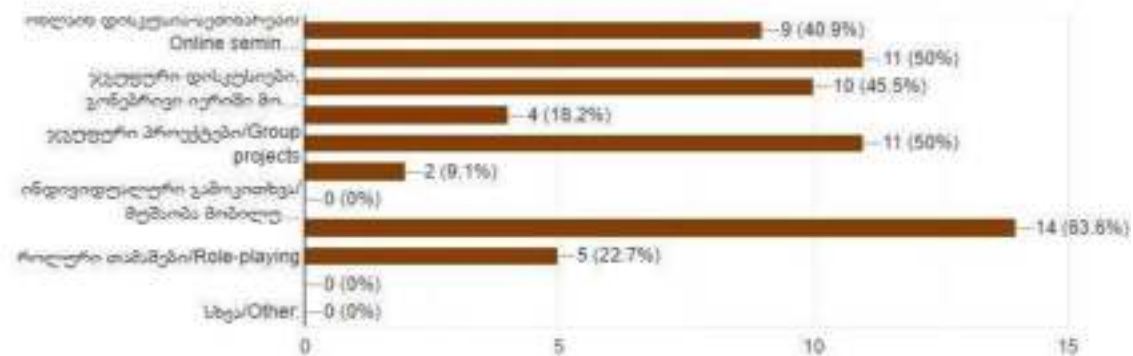

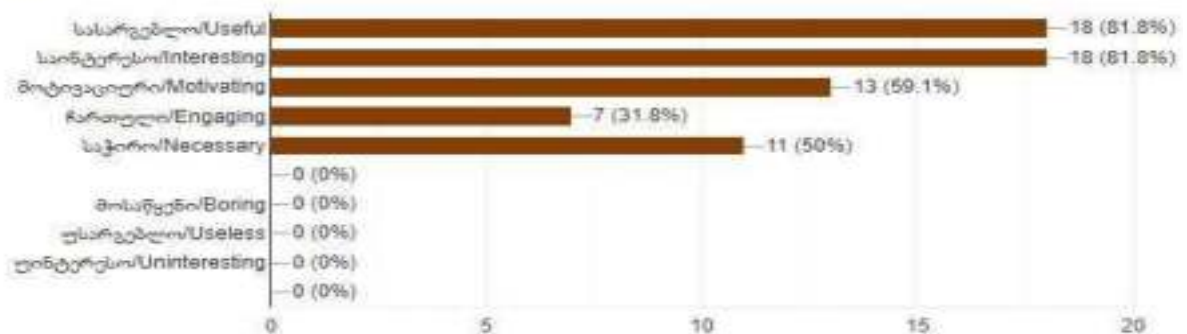

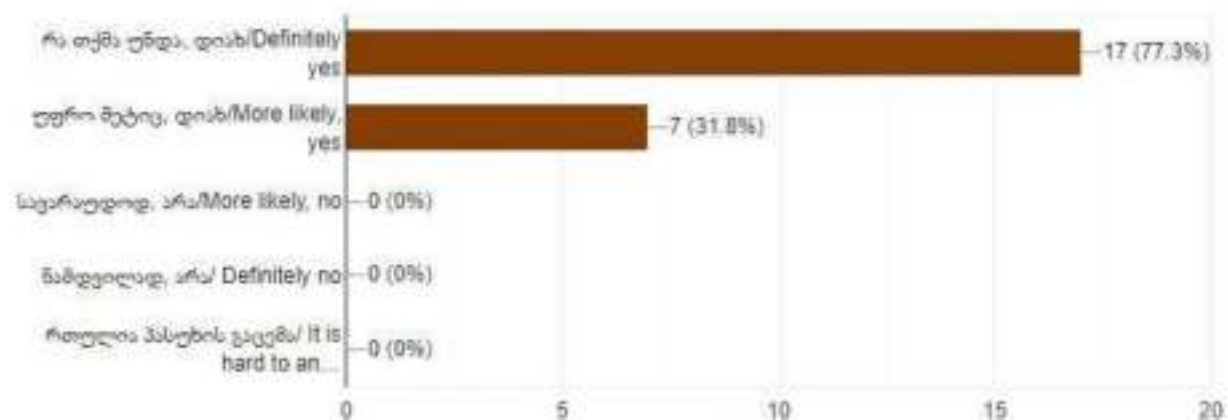

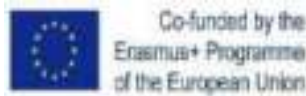

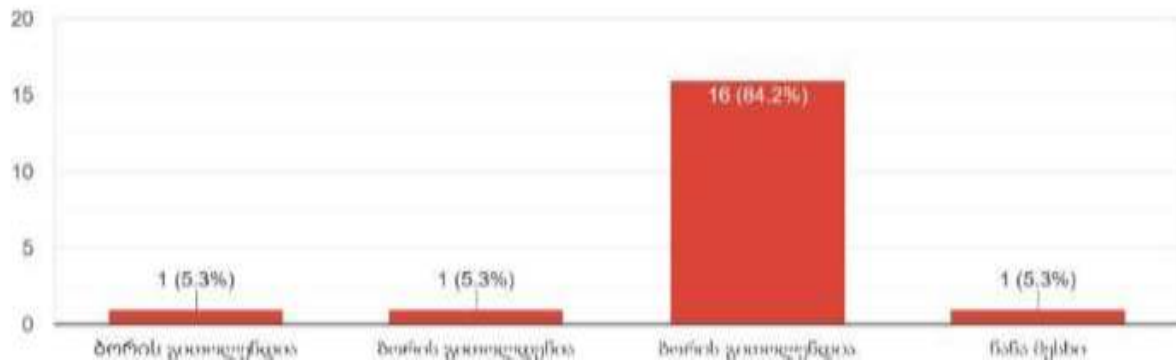

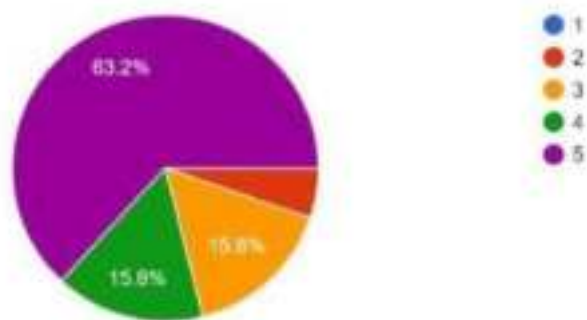

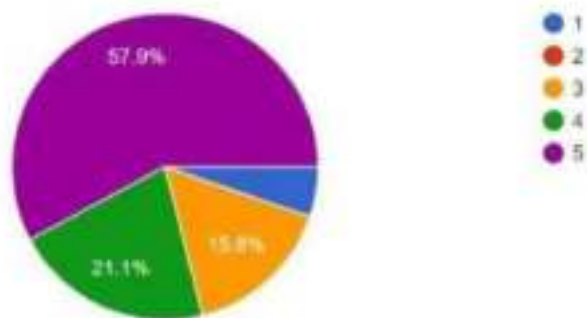

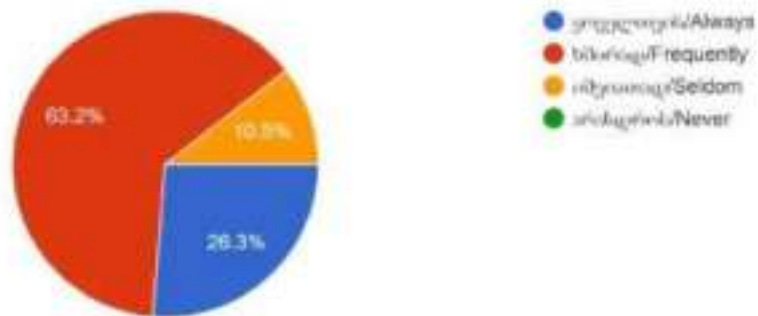

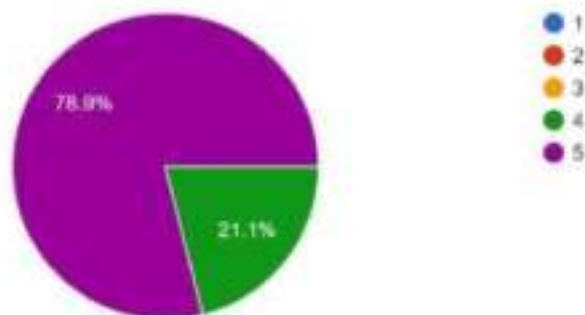

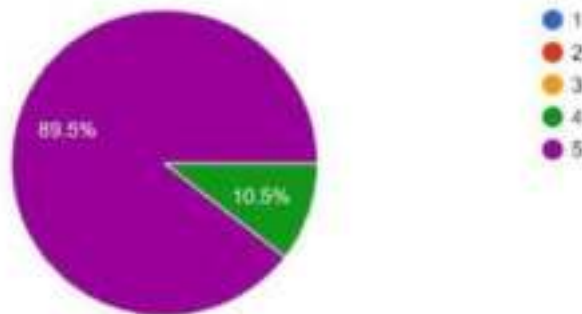

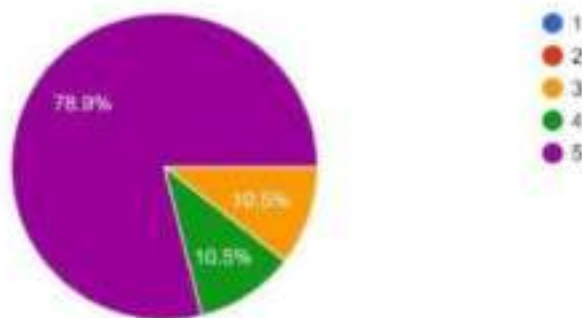

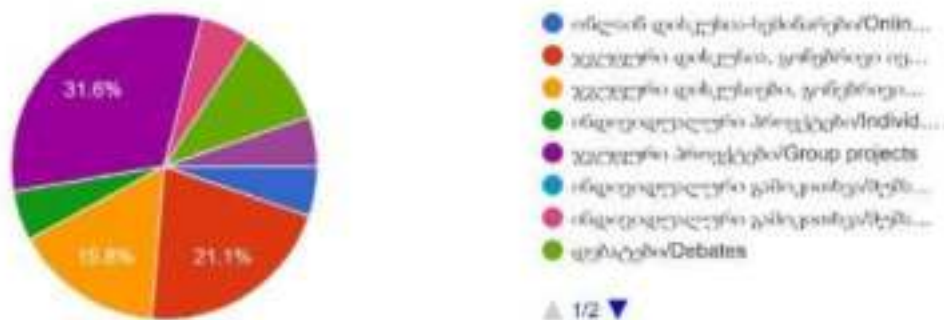

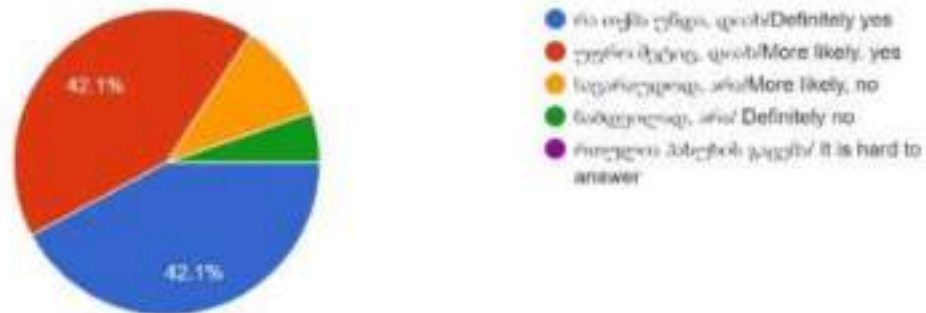

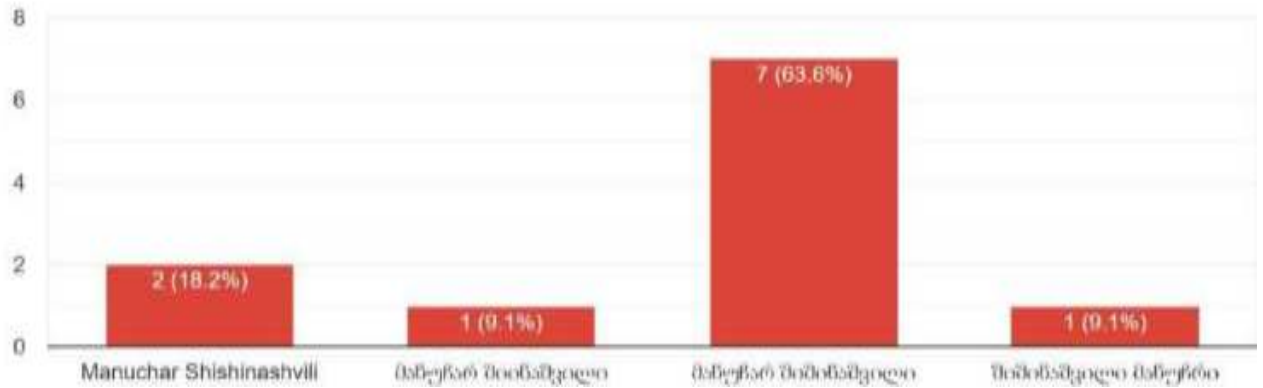

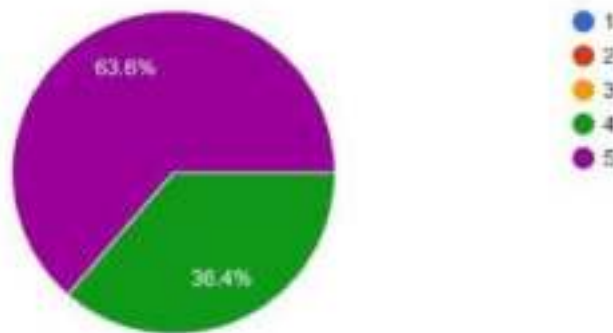

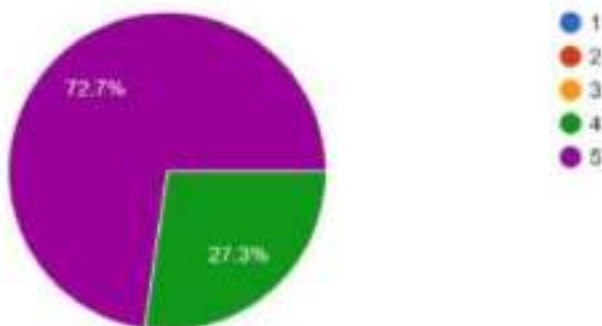

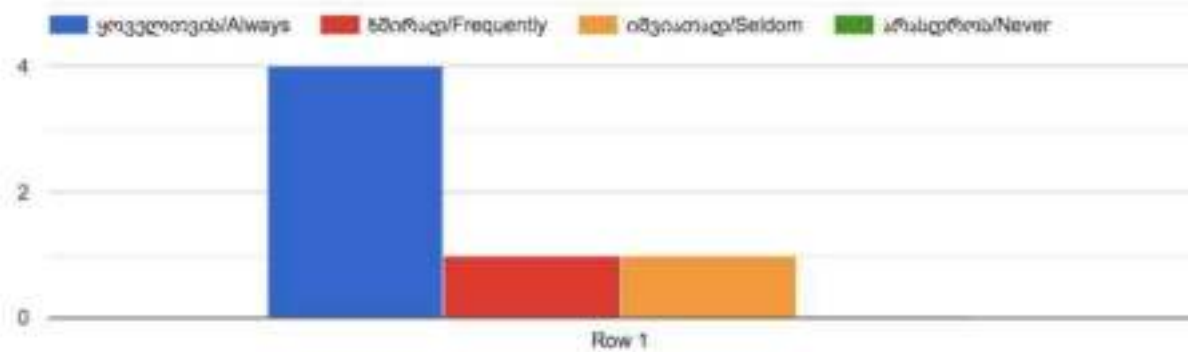

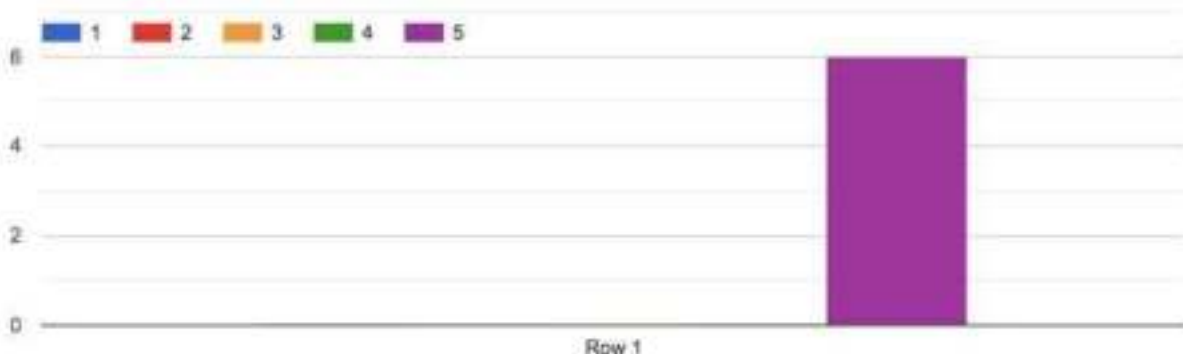

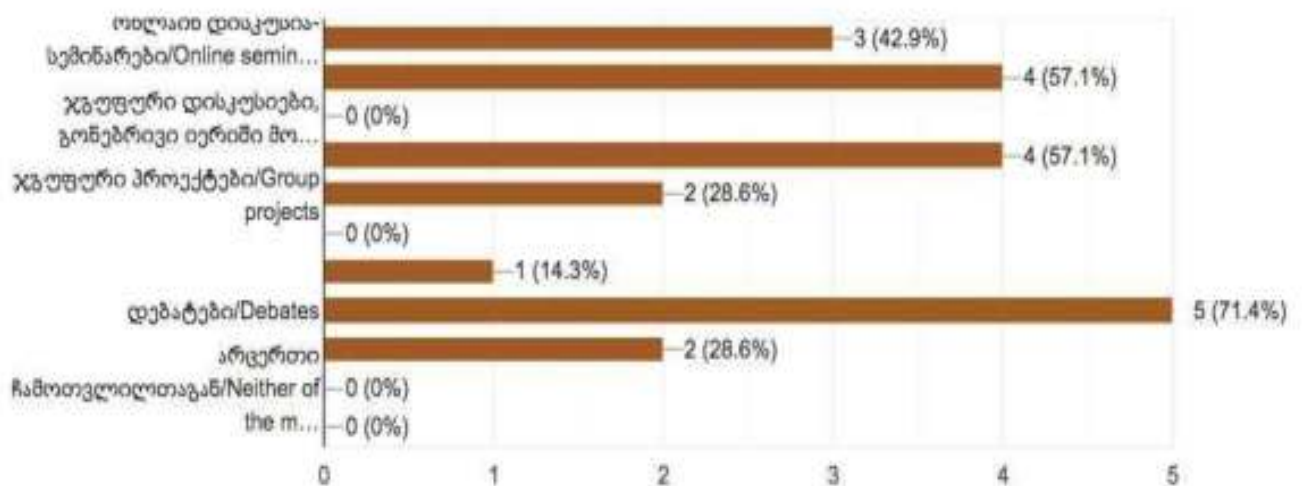

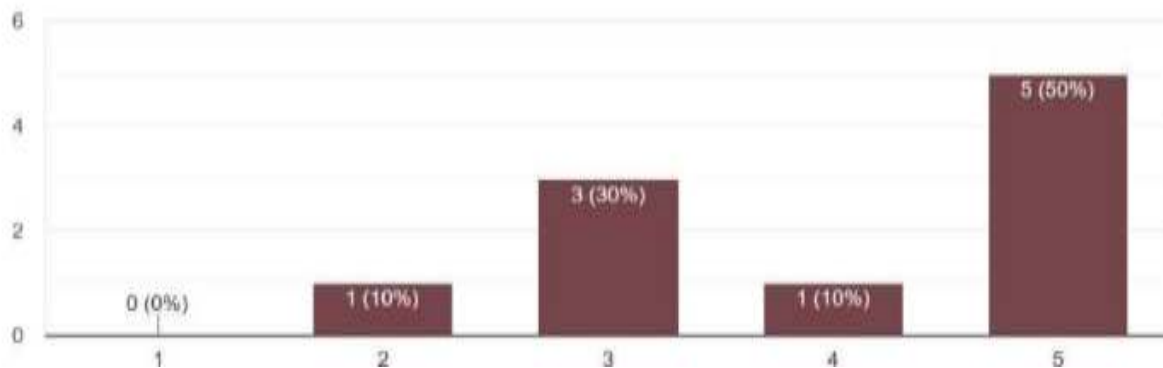

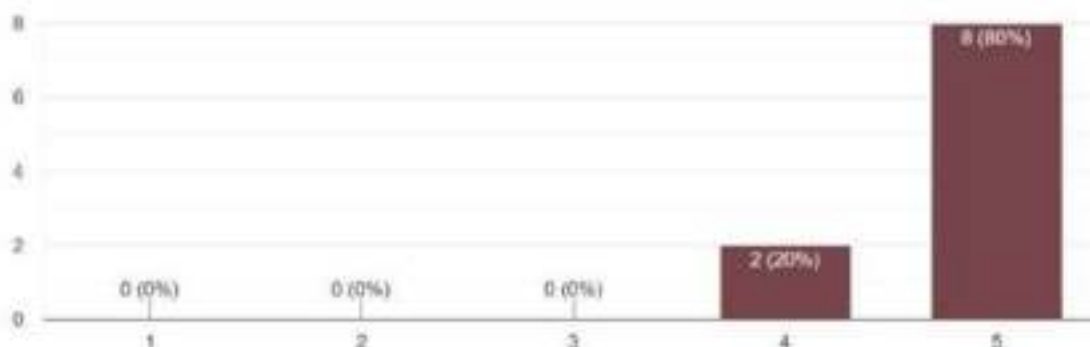

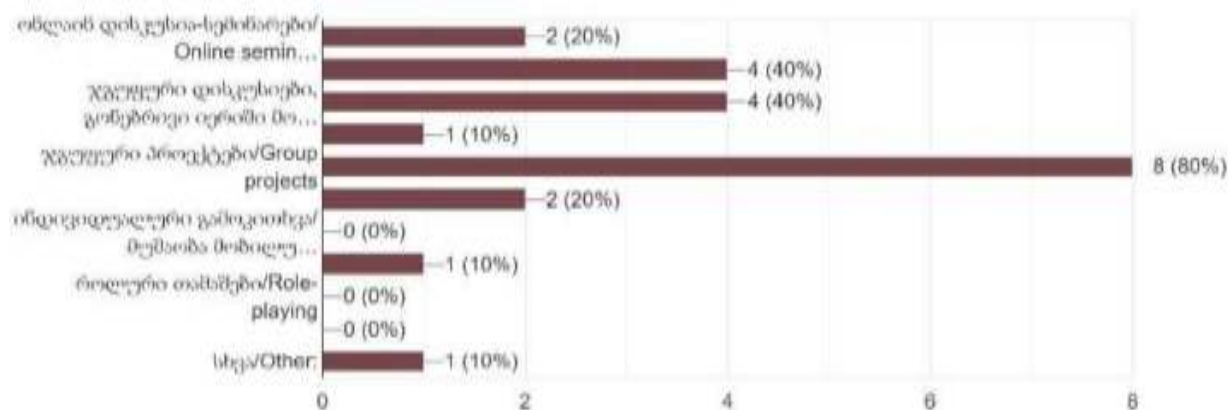

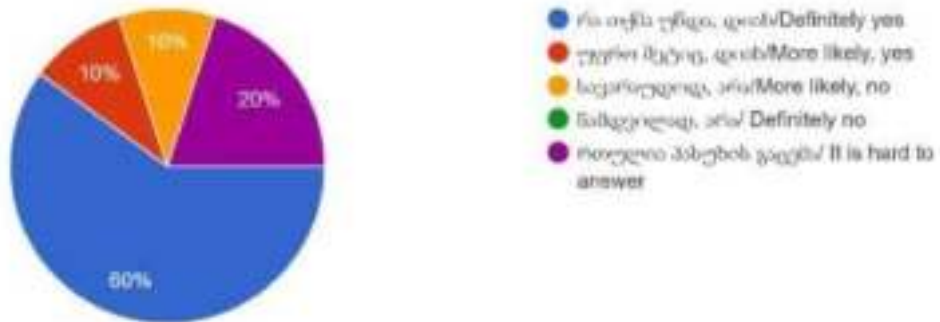

Conclusions and recommendations

Summing up the whole results of the surveys among GTU students provided within the framework of the PRINTeL project's objectives allows to draw the following general conclusions (without dividing into subgroups with different levels of priorities, which will be done later, having the results of all Consortium member universities).

1. In general, most of the students are agreed that:
 - Both the lecturers and students involvement are equally assured during the course;
 - The statement: "The teaching and learning methods applied during the course evoked interest towards the topic and encouraged my learning" is agreed by the students;
 - The students absolutely agreed with the statement: "Students' participation and involvement/engagement in the course was encouraged"
 - In general, most of the students agreed that the active and innovative methods were frequently applied during the course;
 - In general, up to 70% of students agreed that the lecturer uses the active and innovative methods very often;
 - More than 60% of students rated the efficiency of communication between the lecturer and the audience on a 5 - the highest point;
 - 70% of students absolutely agrees to the statement "As a result of the course I have gained team working and cooperation skills which I will be able to use in the future".
2. Based on the results of the surveys provided at GTU it can be mentioned that there is a quite high percentage of traditional teaching methods. At the same time there is a clearly identified tendency of using innovative and technology enhanced T&L methods, tools and technologies introduced already into the educational processes, especially when taking into account COVID-19 situation and its consequences in this regard. To come to final common conclusions on the existing needs and to develop common principles for achieving the main objectives of PRINTeL project, comparative analysis of the similarly processed results of the project consortium member universities' surveys is required.
